

## AMPLIFIERS—315-TYPE

### 1. GENERAL




Fig. 1—315A Amplifier




Fig. 2—315B Amplifier

- 1.01 This section contains identification information for the 315A (Fig. 1) and 315B (Fig. 2) amplifiers for customers with impaired hearing.
- 1.02 Whenever this section is reissued the reason for reissue will appear in this paragraph.

### 2. IDENTIFICATION

- 2.01 The 315A and 315B amplifiers consist of component apparatus mounted on a printed circuit board supported by a plastic chassis. Mounting screws and a coverplate are included.
- 2.02 These amplifiers are components of 226A (315A) and 2226A (315B) hand telephone sets and provide up to 20dB of variable gain in the receive circuit.
- 2.03 These amplifiers are to be used primarily for customers with impaired hearing, although they can also be used in noisy locations. These amplifiers should *not* be used to correct transmission problems.
- 2.04 For installation and maintenance information on these amplifiers, refer to Section 502-303-102.
