

Fig. 1—2702B (MD) Telephone Set, Connections




Fig. 2-\$2702BM Telephone Set, Connections\$




Fig. 3—₱2702BMG Telephone Set, Connections♥




Fig. 4—Method of Terminating D4BT Mounting Cord on Sets with 4010-Type Network




Fig. 5—Method of Terminating D4BT Mounting Cord on Sets with 4228-Type Network
